

NOVI „VRLI“ SVET

Kada smo saopštavali odluke žirija 21. Međunarodnog salona antiratne karikature „Kragujevac 21“, koji se organizuje svake druge godine, jedna mlada novinarka je pitala: „Šta se promenilo za proteklih četrdeset godina, od prvog Salona do danas?“

Na to je verovatno bila ponukana nekolikim okolnostima.

Najpre, pred sobom sam imao katalog prvog Salona, koji je dizajnirao jedan od njegovih pokretača, počivši karikaturista i novinar Aleksandar Dimitrijević. Bila je to skromna, ali elegantna publikacija kvadratnog oblika, u crno-beloj štampi, koja nije mogla da izradi sve nijanse autorske veštine crtanja, ali je mogla snažnu i čitljivu antiratnu poruku. Na kraju tog kataloga, koji je poslat svim učesnicima na konkursu, koji su takođe svoje originalne radove slali poštom, stajalo je: „Doviđenja, prijatelji! So long, friends!“

Drugo, po odluci žirija 21. Salona, Gran pri “Vesnik mira“ dobio je Božo Stefanović iz Sarajeva (Bosna i Hercegovina). Isti onaj Božo koji je bio član žirija Prvog međunarodnog salona antiratne karikature „Kragujevac“. Treće, taj žiri u kome je Božo donosio odluku o dobitnicima, Zlatnu plaketu i prvu nagradu

NEW VIRTOUS WORLD

When we announced the decisions of the jury of The 21st International Anti-War Cartoon Salon "Kragujevac 21", which is organized every second year, a young journalist asked: "What has changed in the past forty years, from the first Salon to today?" She was probably prompted to do so by several circumstances.

First of all, in front of me there is a catalog of the first Salon, which was designed by one of its initiators, a deceased cartoonist and journalist Aleksandar Dimitrijević. It was a modest, but elegant publication of a square shape, in black and white, which could not express all the nuances of the author's drawing skills, but could have a strong and legible anti-war message. At the end of the catalog, which was sent to all participants in the competition, who also sent their original works by mail, it was written: "Goodbye, friends! So long, friends!" Secondly, by the decision of the jury, Božo Stefanović from Sarajevo (Bosnia and Herzegovina) won the Grand Prix of the 21st Salon. The same Božo who was a member of the jury of The First International Anti-War Cartoon Salon "Kragujevac".

na Prvom salonu dodelio je Jugoslavu Vlahoviću, mlađom ali već afirmisanom karikaturisti i dizajneru iz Beograda. Žiri tom odlukom i Jugoslav svojom pobedničkom karikaturom su uspostavili visoki kriterijum svim budućim žirijima u smislu oslobođanja karikatura stereotipnih grafičkih metafora. A sada je taj isti Jugoslav kao član žirija učestvovao u odluci da Božo dobije nagradu.

To su samo neki, što bi rekao Andrić, „znakovi pored puta“ dugog četrdeset godina, koliko Salon traje. A šta se promenilo?

Ne, nismo samo mi, koje Salon okuplja oko sebe kao organizatore i kao učesnike, kao stvaraocu i kao one koji sude o stvaralaštvu drugih, postali pune četiri decenije stariji, ako smo još uvek živi (mnogi iz onog prvog kataloga nažalost nisu). Nisu samo mogućnosti obaveštavanja stvaralaca u svetu postale mnogo veće korišćenjem novih komunikacionih tehnologija (iako je i na Prvom salonu učestvovao Norman Isak sa dalekih Filipina). Nisu samo pojednostavljeni načini dostavljanja radova, bez prevelikih poštanskih troškova kakvi su onda bili. Nisu samo tehnike štampe unapredene da bi katalozi postali likovne galerije inspirativnih karikaturista.

Promenio se čitav svet!

Salon je pokrenut u znak sećanja na zločin koji su nacisti počinili u kragujevačkim Šumaricama pre osamdeset godina sa željom da se to nigde i nikada ne ponovi. U vreme njegovog nastanka u svetu su vođena dva veća rata – Sovjetsko-avganistanski i Iračko-iranski, odnosno Prvi zalivski rat.

A od tada u različitim delovima sveta vođeno je ili još traje 40 (i slovima: četrdeset, a možda i više) ratova. Od Libanskog, Foklandskog, Građanskog u Šri Lanki, pa ratova izazvanih raspadom SSSR i Jugoslavije, zatim Drugi zalivski rat, Građanski rat u Alžиру, NATO bombardovanje SR Jugoslavije, Drugi rat u Kongu, Čečenski rat, Rat u Avganistanu, Obala Slo-novače, Čad, Irak, Somalija, Južna Osetija, Gruzija,

Thirdly, the jury in which Božo made the decision about the winners, awarded the Golden Plaque and the first prize at the First Salon to Jugoslav Vlahović, a young but already well-known cartoonist and designer from Belgrade. With that decision, the jury and Yugoslavia, with their winning caricature, established a high criterion for all future juries in terms of releasing caricatures of stereotypical graphic metaphors. And now that same Yugoslav, as a member of the jury, participated in the decision for Božo to receive the award.

These are just some, as Andrić would say, "signs on the road" for forty years, as long as the Salon lasts. And what has changed? No, we are not the only ones, who gather around the Salon as organizers and participants, as creators and as those who judge the creativity of others, we have become four decades older, if we are still alive (many from the first catalog are unfortunately not alive). Not only the possibilities of informing the creators in the world have become much greater with the use of new communication technologies (although Norman Isak from the distant Philippines also participated in the First Salon). It's not just the simplified ways of submitting works, without the excessive postage costs that they were then. It is not only printing techniques that have been improved to make catalogs art galleries of inspiring cartoonists. The whole world has changed!

The salon was started in memory of the crime that the Nazis committed in Kragujevac's Sumarice eighty years ago, with the desire that it would never happen again. At the time of its emergence, two major wars were fought in the world - the Soviet-Afghan and the Iraqi-Iranian, that is, the First Gulf War. And since then, 40 (and in words: forty, and maybe more) wars have been fought or are still going on in different parts of the world. From Lebanon, the Falklands, the Civil War in Sri Lanka, and the wars caused by the collapse of the USSR and Yugoslavia, then the Second Gulf War, the Civil War in Algeria, NATO bombing of FR

Gaza, Libija, Sirija, Ukrajina, Nagorno-Karabah...

Bombardovanje i uništavanje višedecinjskog građenja i stvaranja, okupacija, otimanje resursa, siromašenje i izgladnjivanje... I sve to uz parole o ljudskim pravima, demokratizaciji, uvođenju reda. Ali po meri nekog dalekog i po jednom jedinstvenom modelu i kalupu za sve bez obzira na tradiciju i lokalno iskustvo.

To je taj gromoglasno promovisani Novi „vrli“ svet!?

Prepoznali su ga karikaturisti i svojim radovima iskazali šta o njemu misle. Na karikaturi koja je osvojila Gran pri neki kontrolori sveg sveta pretresaju(?) izgladnеле, gole i bose ljudе. Ima li većeg sarkazma od toga?! U ratovima stradaju i krv liju i „izvodači ratnih radova“ u ime svojih gospodara u dalekim foteljama, sve po hijerarhijskom sistemu. To je uočio i sjajno izrazio Nikola Konstantinović u svom radu koji je osvojio Zlatnu plaketu i prvu nagradu. Na sva usta se promoviše jednakost muškaraca i žena. A Marzieh Khamizah iz Irana vidi drugačiju stvarnost: dok muškarac, general, sedi i uživa ponosan na svoja odlikovanja, starija žena svoju tugu utapa u fotografije svojih dragih izginulih u besmislenim ratovima u kojima je general „zaradio“ odlikovanja. Karikaturisti na radovima priloženim Salonu svedoče tamnu stranu današnjeg sveta, ali ne pristaju na nju, već joj sude oštricom svoga pera i neusahle imaginacije.

Nije nada sasvim zgasla! Pawit Mongkolnokut sa Tajlanda, dobitnik Srebrne plakete i druge nagrade, u nekom novom vremenu, ratne skalamerije što donose smrt vidi u budućem arheološkom muzeju! Hoćemo li dočekati to vreme? Moramo istrajavati u toj veri. U tome nas hrabri i Jan Michaelis iz Diseldorf u Nemačkoj, koji uz svoj rad šalje i poruku:

„Poštovane gospode i gospodo u Kragujevcu, Molim vas da mi oprostite okrutnost naših baka i deka. Učinimo svet boljim kroz sećanje, ne zaboravivši sva ova zlodela i nudeći dozu humora da nikada više ne dozvolimo da izgubimo našu humanost!“

Yugoslavia, the Second War in Congo, the Chechen War, the War in Afghanistan, Ivory Coast, Chad, Iraq, Somalia, South Georgia, Gaza, Libya, Syria, Ukraine, Nagorno-Karabakh ...

Bombing and destruction of decades of construction and creation, occupation, plunder of resources, impoverishment and starvation ... And all that with slogans about human rights, democratization, introduction of order. But tailored to someone distant and according to a unique model and mold for everyone, regardless of tradition and local experience.

It is that thunderously promoted New "virtuous" world!?

The cartoonists recognized it and expressed what they thought of it with their works. In the caricature that won the Grand Prix, some controllers around the world are searching for (?) the hungry, naked and barefoot people. Is there more sarcasm than that?! In wars, blood is shed and "contractors of war works" in the name of their masters in distant armchairs, all according to the hierarchical system. This was noticed and brilliantly expressed by Nikola Konstantinović in his work, which won the Golden Plaque and the first prize. Equality between men and women is promoted by all means. And Marzieh Khamizah from Iran sees a different reality: while a man, a general, sits and enjoys being proud of his medals, an older woman drowns her grief in photos of her loved ones who died in senseless wars in which the general "earned" his medals.

The caricaturists on the works contributed to the Salon testify to the dark side of today's world, but they do not agree with it, but judge it with the blade of their pen and undried imagination. Pawit Mongkolnokut from Thailand, the winner of the Silver Plaque and other awards, in some new time, sees the war scam that brings death in the future archeological museum! Shall we wait for that time?

I ova jedna poruka opravdava četrdesetogodišnju misiju Salona. Moramo istražati zbog budućnosti, zbog naše dece, zbog gradova prijatelja Kragujevca – Ingolštata, Piteštija, Sirena, Bielsko-Biala, Bidgošča, Karare i desetine gradova okupljenih u Međunarodnoj asocijaciji gradova vesnika mira – zbog stotine umetnika karikature, svih koji su poverovali u smisao Salona, pridružujući mu se od srca. I da odgovorim mladoj novinarki, sa početka priče - mnogo toga se promenilo, ali misija je ostala ista.

Možda možemo izgraditi Novi vrii svet. Bez navodnica!

IZVEŠTAJ O RADU ŽIRIJA XXI MEĐUNARODNOG SALONA ANTIRATNE KARIKATURE "KRAGUJEVAC 2021"

Žiri XXI Međunarodnog salona antiratne karikature »Kragujevac 2021« u sastavu: Massoud Shoja Tabatabai, karikaturista, direktor Teheranske kuće karikature iz Irana, predsednik, Jugoslav Vlahović, karikaturista, ilustrator i dizajner, profesor Špiro Radulović, karikaturista, Tošo Borković, karikaturista i Miodrag Stojilović, novinar i publicista, predsednik Saveta Salona, članovi, zasedao je u Kragujevcu 21. avgusta 2021. godine i konstatovao da je za XXI Salon prispelo 987 radova od 469 autora iz 47 država sa svih kontinenata.

REPORT ON THE WORK OF THE JURY OF THE XXI INTERNATIONAL SALON OF ANTIWAR CARTOON "KRAGUJEVAC 2021"

Jury of the XXI International Salon of Anti-war Cartoon "Kragujevac 2021" composed of: Massoud Shoja Tabatabai, cartoonist, director of the Iranian House of Cartoon in Tehran, president, Jugoslav Vlahović, cartoonist, illustrator and designer, Professor Špiro Radulović, cartoonist, Toso Borković, journalist and cartoonist , President of the Salon Council, members, met in Kragujevac on August 21, 2021 and stated that 987 works by 469 authors from 47 countries from all continents arrived for the XXI Salon.
